EXECUTIVE ORDER #185

Relating to a Proclamation that the State Capitol State Flag
be Flown at Half-Staff in Honor
of Law Enforcement Memorial Day


WHEREAS, law enforcement officials throughout the State of Wisconsin place themselves in imminent danger on a daily basis to protect and serve the citizens of this great state; and

WHEREAS, this service to the public often requires law enforcement officers to give more consideration to the safety of the public than to themselves; and


WHEREAS, it is important and appropriate that we pause to remember those who have fallen in the line of duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by law, do hereby:

Order that the State Capitol State Flag be flown at half-staff on Friday, May 14, 1993 in honor of Law Enforcement Memorial Day.
