EXECUTIVE ORDER #189

**Relating to the Creation of the Governor's Clean Air Act
Amendments Implementation Task Force**


WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin seeks to maintain its leadership in environmental awareness, and

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 will affect the industries, businesses, citizens and agencies of the State of Wisconsin,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

1. Establish the Clean Air Amendments Implementation Task Force with a membership consisting of Secretaries and Heads of Agencies that will be impacted by the Clean Air Act Amendments and four legislators, all appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure.
2. Direct the task force to study and develop recommendations with regard to the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.
