Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by tornados, severe storms, and flooding in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather creates emergencies of concern to the State of Wisconsin; and


WHEREAS, the following counties were affected as a result of tornados, severe storms, and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993;

ADAMS, BUFFALO, CALUMET, CHIPPEWA, CLARK, COLUMBIA, DUNN, EAU CLAIRE, FOND DU LAC, GREEN LAKE, JACKSON, JUNEAU, LACROSSE, MARQUETTE, OUTAGAMIE, PEPIN, PIERCE, PORTAGE, PRICE, RUSK, SAUK, TREMPLEAU, WAUPACA, WAUSHARA, WINNEBAGO AND WOOD.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in the above enumerated counties of this State.
