
EXECUTIVE ORDER #201

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993, in Iowa and Dane Counties in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, additional storms with heavy rains occurred on July 5, 1993, causing additional flooding;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Iowa and Dane Counties.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this sixth day of July in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.
