

EXECUTIVE ORDER #205

Relating to Amending Executive Order #204

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order #204, which called for a special election to fill the vacancy in the twentieth senate district created by the resignation of Senator Donald Stitt, as follows:


The expiration date of the term shall be corrected from the first Monday in January 1995 to the first Monday in January, 1997.
