
EXECUTIVE ORDER #207

Proclamation of a State of Emergency


WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993, in Richland and Monroe Counties in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, additional storms with heavy rains occurred on July 5, 1993, causing additional flooding;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Richland and Monroe Counties.
