
Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993 and continuing, in Menominee and Shawano counties in the State of Wisconsin;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Menominee and Shawano Counties.
