EXECUTIVE ORDER #211

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags
be Flown at Half Staff due to the
Deaths of Six National Guardsmen

WHEREAS, Air National Guardsmen Patrick C. Foran, Michael D. Heath, James R. Russell, James R. Schlicht, Russell H. Shurr and Roy A. Starszak served the State of Wisconsin in the Wisconsin Air National Guard; and


WHEREAS, on December 10, 1993, these men lost their lives while serving the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:


Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half-staff beginning December 13, 1993, until sundown December 14, 1993.
