Relating to a Proclamation Ordering that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half-Staff Due to the Death of Mayor Henry W. Maier


WHEREAS, Mayor Henry W. Maier served as Mayor of the City of Milwaukee with honor and distinction; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Henry W. Maier died on Sunday, July 17, 1994:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds located in the City of Milwaukee be flown at half-staff from July 19, 1994 until sunset July 22, 1994; and


Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds located in the State of Wisconsin be flown at half-staff from sunrise July 22, 1994 until sunset July 22, 1994.
