EXECUTIVE ORDER #229

Proclamation of a State of Emergency and Order to Limited Service of the Wisconsin National Guard

WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by tornados and severe storms in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather creates emergencies of concern to the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, portions of Wisconsin were affected as a result of tornados and severe storms beginning on August 27, 1994;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby:

Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in portions of this State and I direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist state and local government agencies in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the recovery of said tornados.


