EXECUTIVE ORDER #231

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be
Flown at Half Staff due to the Death of Milwaukee
Police Officer William Robertson

WHEREAS, Milwaukee Police Officer, William Robertson, served
the City of Milwaukee in the Milwaukee Police force; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 1994, Officer Robertson lost his
life while in the line of duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State
of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State
law, do hereby;

Order that the National and State flags on all State
buildings and State grounds in Milwaukee County and at the State
Capitol in Madison be flown at half staff beginning September 7,
1994, at 3:00 p.m. until sundown September 10, 1994.

be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the
City of Madison this seventh day of
September in the year one thousand nine
hundred and ninety-four.
