### EXECUTIVE ORDER #238

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be  
Flown at Half Staff due to the Death of Milwaukee  
Police Officer Michael A. Neihoff

WHEREAS, Milwaukee Police Officer, Michael A. Neihoff, served  
the City of Milwaukee in the Milwaukee Police force; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 1994, Officer Neihoff lost his life  
while in the line of duty;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State  
of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State  
law, do hereby;

Order that the National and State flags on all State  
buildings and State grounds in Milwaukee County and at the State  
Capitol in Madison be flown at half staff beginning December 1,  
1994, at 3:00 p.m. until sundown December 4, 1994.


IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have
