EXECUTIVE ORDER #240

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half Staff due to the Death of Milwaukee Firefighter Lionel Hoffer

WHEREAS, Milwaukee Firefighter, Lionel Hoffer, served the City of Milwaukee in the Milwaukee Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 1994, Firefighter Hoffer lost his life while in the line of duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby;

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds in Milwaukee County and at the State Capitol in Madison be flown at half staff beginning December 29, 1994, at sunrise until sundown January 1, 1995.
