EXECUTIVE ORDER #248

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half Staff due to the Bombing of the Alfred Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

WHEREAS, on April 19, 1995 a bomb was detonated at the Alfred Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and


WHEREAS, many adults and children tragically lost their lives; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half-staff beginning April 20, 1995, until sundown April 24, 1995.
