

EXECUTIVE ORDER #249

Relating to a Proclamation that the State Capitol  
State Flag be Flown at Half-Staff in Honor of  
Law Enforcement Memorial Day

WHEREAS, law enforcement officials throughout the State of Wisconsin place themselves in imminent danger on a daily basis to protect and serve the citizens of this great state; and

WHEREAS, this service to the public often requires law enforcement officers to give more consideration to the safety of the public than to themselves; and


WHEREAS, it is important and appropriate that we pause to remember those who have fallen in the line of duty; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute § 14.019, do hereby:


Order that the State Capitol State flag be flown at half-staff on Friday, May 19, 1995 in honor of Law Enforcement Memorial Day.
