EXECUTIVE ORDER #252

Relating to a Special Election for the
Fourteenth State Senate District

WHEREAS, State Senator Joseph Lekan submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the fourteenth Senate District, effective Wednesday, July 5, 1995;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50(4) order that a special election be held on September 12, 1995 to fill the vacancy in the fourteenth Senate District. A description of the boundaries of the fourteenth Senate District as created in *Prosser et. al. v. Elections Board et. al.*, Civil Action 92-C-0078-C (W.D. Wis. 1992) is set out in the 1991-92 Wisconsin Statutes following s. 4.005. The term will expire on the first Monday in January, 1997 and, if a primary is necessary, it shall be held on August 15, 1995. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., July 18, 1995. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
