**EXECUTIVE ORDER #259**

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for The Honorable John R. Plewa, Late Senator of the Seventh Senate District of Wisconsin

WHEREAS, on the evening of September 13, 1995 Senator John R. Plewa passed away; and


WHEREAS, Senator Plewa served in the Wisconsin State Senate from 1984 until his death; and

WHEREAS, Senator Plewa served in the Wisconsin State Assembly from 1973 to 1984; and

WHEREAS, Senator Plewa devoted many years of his life to public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags beginning September 14, 1995 until sundown September 18, 1995.
