EXECUTIVE ORDER #267

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Officer Michael R. Baribeau of the Rice Lake Police Department

WHEREAS, in the early morning hours of December 19, 1995, Police Officer Michael R. Baribeau was killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Officer Baribeau served the people of Rice Lake, the people of Barron County and the people of Rusk County with distinction and honor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown December 22, 1995.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this nineteenth day of December in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
