EXECUTIVE ORDER #268


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Trooper William J. Harris of the Wisconsin State Patrol

WHEREAS, on December 27, 1995, State Trooper William J. Harris died of natural causes while on duty; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Harris faithfully and honorably served the people of Wisconsin for 29 years.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all installations of the Wisconsin State Patrol equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise December 29, 1995 until sundown December 29, 1995.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-eighth day of December in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
