EXECUTIVE ORDER #269

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Sheriff Frederick C. Schram of the Richland County Sheriff's Department

WHEREAS, in the early morning hours of January 1, 1996, Sheriff Frederick C. Schram died of natural causes; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Schram faithfully and honorably served the people of Richland County as Sheriff for 9 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby authorize the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin to be flown at half-staff in Richland County beginning forthwith until sundown January 5, 1996.
