Executive Order #276


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Edmund Sixtus Muskie, Former Secretary of State of the United States of America

WHEREAS, on March 26, 1996, Edmund Sixtus Muskie died of natural causes; and

WHEREAS, Edmund Sixtus Muskie faithfully and honorably served the people of the United States as a United States Senator and as the Secretary of State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin be flown at half-staff at all public buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Saturday, March 30, 1996 until sundown on that date.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-ninth day of March in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-six.
