Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Paul Brehm of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and the Late Ralph Jungbluth of the Waukesha County Highway Department


WHEREAS, Paul Brehm and Ralph Jungbluth died in a tragic accident on Interstate 94 on June 11, 1996; and

WHEREAS, at the time of their death, Mr. Brehm and Mr. Jungbluth were engaged in the important work of maintaining the State's highways; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brehm and Mr. Jungbluth dutifully served the people of this state as highway maintenance technicians;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin located in Waukesha County and at the Headquarters of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation located at the Hill Farms State Office Building in Madison beginning at sunrise on June 15, 1996 until sundown on that date.
