

## EXECUTIVE ORDER #294

## Relating to the Amendment of Executive Order #289


WHEREAS, the Governor's Blue Ribbon Commission on 21st Century Jobs ("Commission") was created on July 1, 1996 by Executive Order #289; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order #289 fixed the size of the Commission at twenty-five (25) members; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to expand the membership of the Commission beyond twenty-five (25);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Section 14.019 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby amend paragraph 2) of Executive Order #289 as follows:

2) Provide that the Commission shall consist of not more than thirty [30] members appointed by the Governor and that the Governor shall designate one member as chair.
