EXECUTIVE ORDER #304


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Assistant Fire Chief Robert Martinson of the Conover Township Fire Department

WHEREAS, on January 26, 1997, Assistant Fire Chief Robert Martinson died in the line of duty while battling a fire in Conover Township; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Martinson bravely and honorably served the people of Conover Township and the people of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown on Wednesday, January 29, 1997.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-eighth day of January in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-seven.
