EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 322

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Assistant Chief Gregory Quinn of the Village of Westfield Volunteer Fire Department

WHEREAS, on November 22, 1997, Assistant Chief Gregory Quinn of the Village of Westfield Volunteer Fire Department died in the line of duty while assisting at an accident scene outside the Village of Westfield; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Quinn bravely and honorably served the people of the Village of Westfield and the people of the State of Wisconsin;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown on Wednesday, November 26, 1997.
