EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 327

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Deputy Sheriff Richard A. Weinke of the Sauk County Sheriff's Office


WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Richard A. Weinke of the Sauk County Sheriff's Office died in the line of duty in the early morning hours of April 5, 1998 in a traffic collision while responding to assist the Sauk Prairie Police Department with a domestic disturbance call, and

WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Weinke faithfully and honorably served the people of Sauk County and the people of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown on the day of Deputy Sheriff Weinke's interment.
