Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be flown at half-staff as a mark of respect for the late John Tomlin


WHEREAS, on April 20, 1999, John Tomlin died in the tragic incident at Columbine High School in Littleton, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, John Tomlin was a former Rochester, Wisconsin resident who attended school in the Waterford Graded School District Joint No. 1; and

WHEREAS, John Tomlin was an exemplary young man who greatly contributed to his community;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby authorize the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin to be flown at half-staff at all public and private buildings in Racine County beginning at sunrise on April 28, 1999 until sunset on that date.
