EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 374


Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe storms accompanied by heavy rainfall occurred in Florence County on July 15, 1999 and July 16, 1999; and


WHEREAS, these intense storms caused extensive damage to individual homes, to the roadway distribution network, and to other public infrastructure in Florence County amounting to a natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Wisconsin, and specifically by Sections 166.03(1)(b) 1 and 21.11(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:


1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Florence County; and
2. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Florence County in recovering from this natural disaster.
