EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 390

Relating to a Consumer Confidence Report Mailing Waiver

WHEREAS, Section 1414(c)(4)(C) of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act allows the Governor of the State of Wisconsin to grant a Consumer Confidence Report Mailing Waiver to community water systems serving fewer than 10,000 persons; and

WHEREAS, Section 1414(c)(4)(D) of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act allows the Governor of the State of Wisconsin to determine not to apply certain mailing and publication requirements to community water systems serving 500 persons or fewer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, do hereby:

1. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources (hereinafter "the Secretary") to notify all community water systems serving fewer than 10,000 persons that they are not required to mail or otherwise provide direct delivery of the Consumer Confidence Reports (hereinafter "CCR") to each customer served by their system; and
2. Require the Secretary to notify water systems serving fewer than 10,000 persons that this mailing waiver shall be granted for the period beginning May 1, 2000; and
3. Require that each water system serving fewer than 10,000 persons shall do all of the following:
 - (a) Directly inform each customer by mail, door to door delivery, or other method approved by the DNR that the water system will not be mailing customers copies of the CCR except upon request; and
 - (b) Publish CCR annually in one or more local newspaper serving areas in which the system's customers are located; and
 - (c) Make copies of the CCR available to the public upon request; and
4. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources to notify all community water systems which serve 500 persons or fewer, a waiver is hereby granted for the period beginning May 1, 2000; and
5. Exempt all community water systems which serve 500 persons or fewer from the requirements of 3(a) and 3(b) of this Executive Order; and


6. Require each water system serving 500 persons or fewer to provide notice to each of its customers at least once per year, by mail, door-to-door delivery, or other methods authorized by the Department of Natural Resources, of the availability of the printed CCR; and
7. Direct all systems with mailing waivers to:
 - (a) Complete a CCR in accordance with all content requirements.
 - (b) Provide a copy of the CCR to the Department of Natural Resources and any other agency specified by the DNR.
 - (c) Make copies of the CCR available to the public upon request.
