EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 394

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe storms and high-winds occurred in Manitowoc County on May 12, 2000; and


WHEREAS, these intense storms caused extensive damage to individual homes and to public infrastructure in Manitowoc County amounting to a natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Wisconsin, and specifically by Sections 166.03(1)(b) 1 and 21.11(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Manitowoc County; and
2. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Manitowoc County in recovering from this natural disaster.
