

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 399

Relating to the Amendment of Executive Order No. 398


WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared in Executive Order No. 398 for Adams, Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Grant, Green, Iowa, Juneau, LaCrosse, Lafayette, Monroe, Richland, Rock, Sauk and Vernon Counties in the State of Wisconsin due to damage caused by severe storms with high-winds, hail and intense rain starting on May 26, 2000 and extending for numerous days thereafter; and

WHEREAS, Jackson, Kenosha and Walworth Counties were also severely impacted by these extremely severe storms;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by sections 166.03(1)(b)1 and 21.11(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby amend Executive Order No. 398 to provide that a State of Emergency exists in Jackson, Kenosha and Walworth Counties.
