

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 405

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Two Late Sheriff's Deputies of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department Who Lost Their Lives in a Helicopter Crash


WHEREAS, on August 17, 2000, two Sheriff's Deputies of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department died in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the two Deputies bravely and honorably served the people of Milwaukee County and the State of Wisconsin;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 18, 2000 and ending at sunset on that date;
