EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 406


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Deputy Sheriff Ralph E. Zylka and Deputy Sheriff Sung Hui Bang of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office Who Lost Their Lives in a Helicopter Crash

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2000, Deputy Sheriff Ralph E. Zylka and Deputy Sheriff Sung Hui Bang of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office died in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Zylka and Deputy Sheriff Bang bravely and honorably served the people of Milwaukee County and the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown on August 23, 2000;
