

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 51


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Officers Robert Etter and Stephanie Markins of the Hobart-Lawrence Police Department

WHEREAS, on Monday, July 22, 2002, Police Officer Robert Etter and Police Officer Stephanie Markins were killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Officer Etter and Officer Markins served the people of Hobart and Lawrence and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the deaths of Officer Etter and Officer Markins;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott McCallum, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise Friday, July 26, 2002, until sundown Saturday, July 27, 2002.
