EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 60

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Honorable Joseph Andrea, former Wisconsin State Legislator

WHEREAS, on the morning of December 5, 2002, Former State Senator Joseph Andrea passed away; and

WHEREAS, Senator Andrea served the Wisconsin State Assembly and Senate from 1977 through 1996; and

WHEREAS, Senator Andrea devoted many years of his life to public service; and


WHEREAS, he showed a true propensity for bipartisanship; and

WHEREAS, he was known as a vigorous advocate for the people of the Kenosha area; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin will remember Senator Andrea fondly;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott McCallum, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags on December 11, 2002.
