EXECUTIVE ORDER # 183

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Army Corporal Matthew Grimm of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on January 15, 2007, Army Corporal Matthew Grimm, a member of 2nd Squadron, 7th Cavalry Regiment, 4th Brigade Combat Team, 1st Cavalry Division, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Army Corporal Matthew Grimm provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Army Corporal Matthew Grimm; and

WHEREAS, Army Corporal Matthew Grimm will be laid to rest on Saturday, January 27, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on January 27, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
