**EXECUTIVE ORDER # 190**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Harry Timberman of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom**


**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2007, Lance Corporal Timberman, a member of 2nd Battalion, 7th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force, United States Marine Corps, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

**WHEREAS**, Lance Corporal Timberman provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Timberman; and

**WHEREAS**, Lance Corporal Timberman will be laid to rest on Saturday, April 7, 2007;


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on April 7, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
