
WHEREAS, on Wednesday, May 16, 2007, Kenosha Sheriff's Deputy Frank Fabiano, Jr. was killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Frank Fabiano, Jr. served the people of Kenosha County and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Deputy Frank Fabiano, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Frank Fabiano, Jr. will be laid to rest on Wednesday, May 23, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Wednesday, May 23, 2007 and ending at sunset on that date.
