EXECUTIVE ORDER # 202

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant First Class Jesse Albrecht of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on May 17, 2007, Sergeant First Class Jesse Albrecht, a member of 725th Brigade Support Battalion, 4th Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Jesse Albrecht provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sergeant First Class Jesse Albrecht; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Jesse Albrecht will be laid to rest on Saturday, May 26, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on May 26, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
