**EXECUTIVE ORDER #205**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant Tyler Kritz of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom**


**WHEREAS**, on June 3, 2007, Sergeant Tyler Kritz, a member of 1st Battalion; 37th Field Artillery Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division, (Stryker Brigade Combat Team), died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Tyler Kritz provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sergeant Tyler Kritz; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Tyler Kritz will be laid to rest on Monday, June 11, 2007;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **June 11, 2007**, and ending at sunset on that date.
