EXECUTIVE ORDER # 223

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for 2nd Lieutenant Tracy Alger of the United States Army Who Lost Her Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on November 1, 2007, 2nd Lieutenant Tracy Alger, a member of the Company F, 626th Brigade Support Battalion, attached to 3rd Battalion, 187th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during combat action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, 2nd Lieutenant Tracy Alger provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of 2nd Lieutenant Tracy Alger; and

WHEREAS, 2nd Lieutenant Tracy Alger will be laid to rest on Saturday, November 10, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on November 10, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
