



**EXECUTIVE ORDER # 323**

**Relating to the Closure of the Milwaukee State Office Building due to Power Outages Caused by Extreme Weather**


**WHEREAS**, on July 22 and July 23, 2010, severe thunderstorms and heavy rains caused flash flooding in Milwaukee County and extensive power outages; and

**WHEREAS**, the Milwaukee State Office Building at 819 N. 6<sup>th</sup> Street in the city of Milwaukee is without power; and


**WHEREAS**, state government functions cannot be delivered at the Milwaukee State Office Building on July 23, 2010, due to the absence of power;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Section 230.35(5)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:**


1. Direct that the Milwaukee State Office Building located at 819 N. 6<sup>th</sup> Street in Milwaukee be closed for public business on July 23, 2010; and
2. Authorize all state agencies to direct employees assigned to the Milwaukee State Office Building not to report to work at the Milwaukee State Office Building on July 23, 2010.
