
WHEREAS, on August 7, 2011, Iowa County Clerk of Circuit Court Carolyn K. Olson passed away after an eight-year battle with cancer; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn K. Olson faithfully and honorably served the people of Iowa County and the State of Wisconsin as Iowa County Clerk of Circuit Court from 1983 until she passed away; and


WHEREAS, Carolyn K. Olson devoted thirty-three years of her life to public service; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Carolyn K. Olson on August 11, 2011;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff at all public buildings equipped with such flags in Iowa County beginning at sunrise on **Thursday, August 11, 2011**, and ending at sunset on that date.


