2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In s. Tour 1.02 (6), the definition of "project" contains substantive provisions that should be placed in a separate provision of the rule regarding qualifications or eligibility of projects for funding. [See s. 1.01 (7) (b), Manual.] However, if the structure of s. Tour 1.02 (6) is not changed, the introduction should be rewritten so that it reads as follows:

"Project" means an activity the purpose of which is to increase tourism. "Project" includes the development of publicity, the development and media placement of advertising or direct mail that accomplishes any of the following:

Also, s. Tour 1.02 (6) (e) should be rewritten to read: "The project publicizes a one-time, one of a kind event of major significance that has the potential to generate media coverage at least throughout the midwest.

b. In s. Tour 1.05 (3) (d) and (f), it appears that commas should be inserted before and after the phrase "if the project relates to an existed event."
