2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

- a. The rule does not have an introductory clause. [See s. 1.02 (1), Manual.]
- b. The treatment clause of Section 1 of the rule should read: "Section 1. ElBd 1.85 (1) and (4) are amended to read:". [See s. 1.04 (2) (a) 4., Manual.]
 - c. The title of s. ElBd 1.85 should not be shown. [See s. 1.05 (3) (d), Manual.]
- d. The comma immediately preceding the underscored material in s. ElBd 1.85 (1) should also be underscored because it is being added. In contrast, the period at the end of the same underscored material should not be underscored because it is already present in the current rule. [See s. 1.06 (4), Manual.]
- e. In s. ElBd 1.85 (4), the word "the" preceding the word "<u>full</u>", the first two commas and the word "the" preceding the word "principal" should be underscored as new material. In addition, "<u>\$100</u>" should follow "<u>\$50</u>". [See s. 1.06 (1), Manual.]
