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CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 98–022

Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

- a. The relating clause of the rule should be changed to delete the reference to "housekeeping" since the rule does not relate to housekeeping. If a general relating clause is desired, the word "various" or "miscellaneous" or a word having a similar meaning could be inserted before the word "wildlife."
- b. In Section 5 of the rule, there is no need to create a par. (a). Therefore, the "(a)" should be deleted.
- c. In Section 7 of the rule, because the comma before the word "Wisconsin" does not appear in the original text of the rule, it should be underscored.
- d. In the effective date provision of the rule, the phrase "in the Wisconsin administrative register" should be inserted after "publication." [See s. 1.02 (4) (a), Manual.]

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

- a. Is the word "for" in the material added to s. NR 10.09 (1) (a) 3. b. necessary?
- b. In s. NR 11.10 (intro.), the word "for" follows the word "established." However, in the current rule, the word "in" follows the word "established." This change is not noted with the appropriate underscores and strike-throughs.
