CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 98-082

Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

In s. Trans 132.06 (5), the second sentence should be written in the active voice--“The dealer shall give”

4. Adequacy of References to Related Statutes, Rules and Forms

In s. Trans 132.06 (1), should the reference to sub. (2) be to sub. (4) instead? In the alternative, should it be to subs. (2) and (4)?

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

It is suggested that the phrase “if the dealer has received all information and money required under sub. (4)” be placed after the word “less” in s. 132.06 (2) and after the word “dealer” at the end of the first sentence in s. 132.06 (3).
