2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

In s. NR 20.02 (2), the term "Green Bay" should be consistently capitalized. In addition, the words "government" and "lighthouse" in the underscored material should not be capitalized. Finally, "Green Bay shall mean" should be ""Green Bay" means."
