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## **CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 99-151**

### **Comments**

#### **2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code**

- a. The analysis to the rule should explain why the rule prohibits Wisconsin grade labeling of cheese from other states or countries.
- b. The analysis to the rule should explain why, in s. ATCP 81.22 (1), the phrase “if there is a Wisconsin grade standard for that variety in subchapters IV to VII” is added.
- c. In the first sentence added to s. ATCP 81.20 (intro.), “cheese” should be changed to “the cheese.”
- d. The phrase added to s. ATCP 81.24 (1) should be stated in the affirmative. For example, that phrase could be rewritten as follows: “A dairy plant licensed under s. 97.20, Stats., may cut, wrap and grade label cheese for retail distribution if the cheese is graded by a cheese grader licensed under s. 97.175, Stats., and the retail packages are grade labeled as required under s. ATCP 81.22.”
