Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. The rule contains two errors of amending current text. First, in the sixth line of s. NR 25.02 (25), at the beginning of the last set of stricken material, the notation "and, should be replaced by "except that." Second, in the last phrase of the entry under "Lake Michigan" in s. NR 25.05 (1) (d), the word "deeper" should not be underscored.

b. The cross-references at the end of the entry under "Lake Michigan" in s. NR 25.05 (1) (d) should be omitted; since chub fishing on Lake Michigan is subject to the cross-referenced sections regardless of s. NR 25.05 (1) (d), the cross-references are superfluous.

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

The analysis should state that SECTION 1 of the rule expands the area of the southern chub fishing zone. The rule does not expand the area of Lake Michigan.
